It will feature a replica of the grand staircase and a fully conserved 16' launching crane used to lower the massive wooden lifeboats, both of which have never been seen in Ohio. Visit and see more than 250 authentic artifacts that tell the human and physical story of the most famous luxury liner in history.

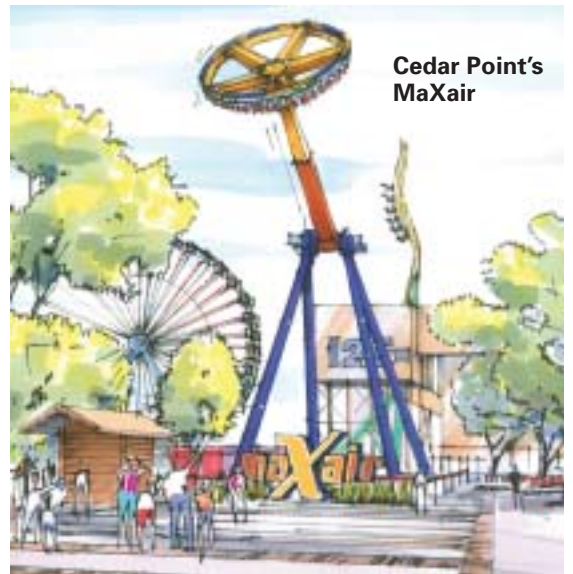

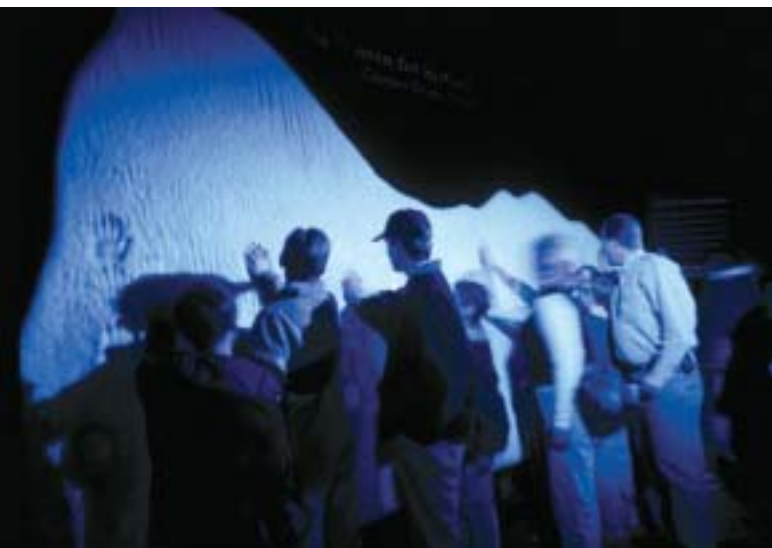

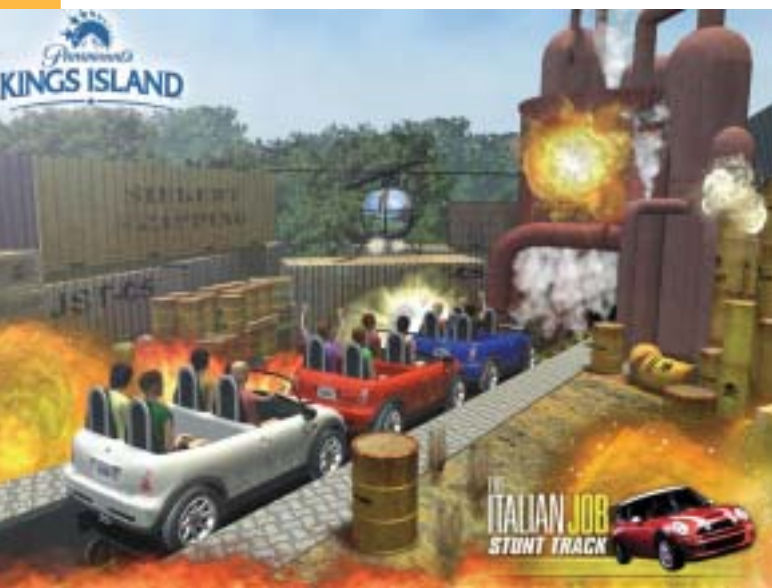
